- ◆ For Interpreters, Door Clerks and Information Clerks the salary is \$200.00 for working an Election Day, \$25.00 for attending a training class and passing the exam. A \$35.00 bonus will be given to those attending class, passing the exam, and working two Election Days.
- ◆ For Inspectors and Poll Clerks the salary is \$200.00 for working an Election Day, \$100.00 for attending a 6-hour training class and passing the exam. A \$75.00 bonus will be given to those attending class, passing the exam and working two Election Days.
- ◆ Any worker who does not attend a training class, will not be assigned to work an Election Day.
- ◆ Any worker who does not work an Election Day will not receive payment for attending class.
